Jan. 4-Jan. 22	Star Event Registration open, \$10 per participant, use DLG system on Utah FCCLA website.
Jan. 23-Jan. 28	Late Star Event Registration open, \$15 per participant, use DLG system on Utah FCCLA website.
Jan.29-Feb. 2	Advisers upload students' projects. Save as documents as PDF.
February 3-5	Evaluation of projects.
February 8-10	Room consultants finalize scores.
February 11-12	LIVE closing/award sessions for each region; Sessions will be recorded to view at a later date if chapters are unable to attend "live".

Reminders

- All students and advisors need to be nationally affiliated before registering.
- List teams members as the same team number.
- Double-check the correct competition level. To be level 3 students must be in or have taken one of the following classes:
 - Culinary Arts/Management
 - Early Childhood Education I & II, Early Childhood Intern
 - Textile Design
 - Entrepreneurship
 - Interior Design II
 - Advanced Interior Design
- Once a student is affiliated as level 3, they remain level 3 in all other affiliations throughout high school.
- Culinary Arts and Baking and Pastry are individual events, teams are no longer permitted.
- Students should follow the FCCLA dress code while recording presentations and to the awards session. Red, black, white or khaki. Advisers should be in business casual dress. (No Jeans, leggings or tennis shoes, flip flops)
- Students will NOT ADVANCE to state in March if they do not have a score of **50 points or higher**. Follow the STAR events manual virtual competition carefully.
- There has been a change with the STAR Events Online Project Summary Form. It is now available in the National FCCLA Portal, located on the "Surveys" tab.
